

NDPA Lunchroom Guidelines

The Lunchroom Staff welcomes you back to school!

Here are a few lunch room guidelines which will keep our lunchroom successful. Parents and students, please take a moment to review.

- 1. You can only come through the lunch line if you are purchasing a school lunch.**
 - **Note: Students coming through the school lunch line will be marked as eating and charged for a school lunch.**
- 2. Food is to be eaten in the lunch room.**
- 3. Milk is an optional item and students are not required to take milk.**
- 4. Students must take one main Entrée Item and two side dishes and milk counts as a side dish.**
- 5. Sometimes there are special side options. The limit is one serving when specified. For example: Sherbet cups, Pudding, tarts etc.**
- 6. The salad bar is not an all you can eat salad buffet. You may go once through the salad bar. Once you leave the salad bar, you may not return.**
 - **Note: We have a vegetable and fruit bar with a wide variety of choices. You may take what you want, but please eat what you take. We reserve the right to limit servings to one of each if we find it necessary.**
- 7. Silverware packs, dressings, condiments, etc. are only for individuals who have purchased school lunch. Please, NO EXCEPTIONS.**
- 8. If your friend is having home lunch and wants chips, pudding, apples, etc. they must purchase them. It is dishonest and unfair to NDPA to take extras for yourself or others.**
- 9. Please show Lion Pride in the school lunchroom.**
 - **Be sure to clean up your area after eating. Please do not leave wrappers, food, and trash etc. on the table.**
 - **Notify our lunchroom staff if there is a spill or problem.**
 - **Remember, you may be asked to return and help pick up items at your seat.**
- 10. Remember to be courteous, kind and helpful to all.**

PARENTS, PARENTS, PARENTS:

Please make sure your child has money in their lunch account. Many options are available for you to pay.

- You may pay at the school (Cash, Money order or Check)
- When writing a check or Money Order to NDPA for your student.
 - Note: For more than one student, please indicate student(s) name(s) in the memo line and if left un-specified, we will divide the amounts to balance each of your student(s) accounts.
- Send payment to Davis Nutrition
 - Pay online with a debit or credit card (there is a fee for this service), or
 - Arrange for an automatic withdrawal which is an easy way to make sure your child has money in their account monthly. Applications are available in the lunch room or should have been sent home with your child.

When there is no money in your child's account, they will be given only one day grace of an emergency meal, before the student will be asked to call home. NDPA's lunch program cannot carry unpaid lunch accounts. Please plan ahead and avoid embarrassment to student(s) or family.

Free and Reduced Lunch Application Information:

A Free and reduced lunch application should have been sent home to each family. If you have student(s) at other Davis County School District Schools, you only need to fill out one application per house hold. If you did not receive an application they are available in the lunch room on top of the milk cooler. You may submit an application at anytime during the year. If you qualified for the 2007-2008 school year it will only be in effect for the first 25 days of this school year. This is a grace period which allows you to reapply. You must reapply if you would like to qualify for free and reduced school lunch for this school year.
