Here is a yummy and easy recipe to ease up your day. Simply throw the ingredients in the crockpot in the morning, and come home to a yummy prepared meal at the end of the day.

Crock Pot Chicken Chili

1 (15 oz.) can of each: pinto beans, white beans, kidney beans, and black beans

1 (7 to 11oz.) can of each: corn (drained), tomatoes with chilies

1 (28 oz.) can diced tomatoes

1 (4 oz.) can diced green chilies

1 envelope chili seasoning mix

1 envelope ranch powdered dressing mix

3 to 4 chicken breasts, shredded

1 can chicken broth

Bake chicken in casserole dish with chicken broth for one hour on 350. When done, shred into pot with the rest of soup ingredients. Cook on low for at least four hours.
