Our basketball team won another game Friday night against Legacy Preparatory Academy. 54-48 **Way to Go Team!** This brings our record to 10 and 3.

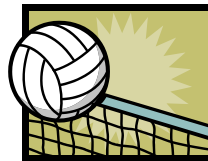
### **Cold Weather Reminder!**
