## SCHOOL REMINDERS:

### SOMETHING NEW TO INSURE SAFETY AT NDPA:

Beginning Monday, February 5, 2007 pick up will be handled with some changes. Students will remain in the Gym for daily pick-up. Faculty and staff will be facilitating the children's departure by organizing students to send them out as their car pulls forward. Drivers will keep the same flow of traffic. Students will be dismissed thru the same exits as usual. Older student carpools on the North of the school and younger grade carpools thru the parking area plan. We ask that you line up as usual, pull forward as directed by the staff be patient as we work to make this a positive transition.

To assist in the new plan, we ask that ***ALL arriving parents and carpools make a window sign not less than 14X11 inches with the name of the carpool in LARGE READABLE LETTERING.*** Be sure to remind your students as you bring them to school to know the name of the sign and who is to pick them up.
