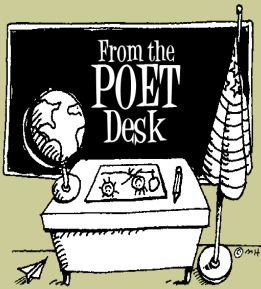
ATTENTION 8TH GRADE PARENTS:
