Please remember these prices DO NOT include any individual child's account balance which could be negative, positive, or zero. You must make the mathematical adjustments accordingly.

Under the direction of the Kitchen Manager, the Cafeteria Worker will prepare, cook and serve a variety of food in large quantity; prepare assigned food, serving areas and perform cashiering duties in the sale of food items to students and staff as assigned.
