## Time to Schedule our Final PTC Appointments!

Our 3<sup>rd</sup> Trimester Mid Term Parent Teacher Conferences are scheduled for March 31 and April 1<sup>st</sup>. These will be short day schedules with conferences running between 2:00 and 7:30pm. There will be NO SCHOOL on Friday April 2<sup>nd</sup>. It is a "Teacher Compensation Day". (Note: Spring Break will begin the following week April 5th through April 9<sup>th</sup>. We will return to classes on Monday, April 12<sup>th</sup>.)



- Jr. High Grade teachers will be on a first come first served basis in their individual class rooms to accommodate parents as needed.
- K-6 are by appointment with both team teachers at the same appointment time. The online scheduler will be available for parents to schedule their own appointments **beginning March 13<sup>th</sup> at 12:01am** and will close for parent scheduling on March 23<sup>rd</sup> at midnight. This program will allow you to schedule your own appointments with your student(s) teaching team. If you fail to schedule your own appointment, your teacher(s) will select an appointment for you based on remaining availability after March 23<sup>rd</sup>. We encourage you to take advantage and scheduler early for a better selection of times for your appointments. **Be sure to allow at least a 10 minute time for movement between the buildings when scheduling more than one K-6 appointment close together.**

## CHEERLEADER TRYOUTS FOR 6-8TH GRADERS—Note Date Change!



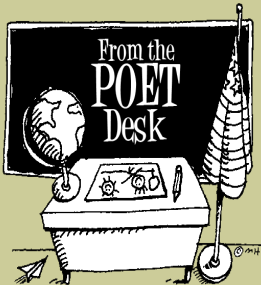
