Kitchen:

Under the direction of the Kitchen Manager, the Cafeteria Worker will prepare, cook and serve a variety of food in large quantities; prepare assigned food, serving areas and perform cashiering duties in the sale of food items to students and staff as assigned. He/she will be required to maintain cleanliness of food service facilities; and as assigned, assist other food service personnel. This applicant must be able to stand for long periods of time, be able to reach, bend, twist and have the ability to lift, move, and/or carry 50+ lbs repeatedly. Applicant must have or secure a current Food Handlers Permit and acquire a Life Scan fingerprint and background check. This individual will work 8-12 hours per week with a starting wage of \$8.50 per hour. Please pick up an application in the school office. Questions contact LaRetta Foxley in the lunchroom.

- Supervise playground activity.
- Maintain a safe and secure play area.
- Inform office of any safety issues or concerns.

- At the end of the day, assist students to secure and put away all equipment.
