UPDATE ON SPANISH IMMERSION PROGRAM

We are very excited about the enthusiastic response to the Spanish Immersion Program. There are still a few openings if you want to enroll your student. Here are the counts:

Grade	# of Sections of Immersion	Availability
1st grade	2	3 slots available for Immersion class
2nd grade	2	FULL (there are currently 15 people on a waiting list)
3rd grade	1*	FULL (there are currently 13 people on a waiting list)
4th grade	2	FULL (there are currently 4 people on a waiting list)
5th grade	1*	FULL (there are currently 10 people on a waiting list)
6th grade	2	1 slot available for Immersion class

*In 3rd and 5th grades there is a possibility of another section opening up for an immersion class.

3rd grade - If 11 more student sign up, we could open up a second section of immersion

5th grade - If 9 additional students sign up, we could open up a second section of immersion

There is still time for you to enroll your student in the immersion program. Students of all abilities are invited to apply. Remember we ask that you commit to keep your student in the program for 2 full years. Sign up at www.northdavisprep.org and click on the icon of the two flags to sign up.

If you plan to return to your neighborhood school next year - June 30th Deadline!!

If you are planning on transferring your student out of NDPA to return to your neighborhood school, NDPA must notify those schools by June 30, 2010. If the district school does not know that you intend to transfer to their school by June 30th, they may deny you enrollment. The district will allow your student to attend a school, but they may not allow you to attend your neighborhood school in order to avoid overcrowded classrooms.

The following procedures have been developed to ensure that all NDPA students who wish to transfer to their neighborhood school will meet the deadline. Here is what you will need do:

1. You must notify NDPA that you will not be returning to our school next fall by May 28, 2010.

NDPA will notify the district that you are returning for you. Some of you completed this step because you have already notified us by filling out the NDPA Re-enrollment form (green paper) last January.

Some of you have completed this step because you notified us by letter or email.

If you have not notified NDPA, or if you told us you were returning and now your circumstances have changed, you must notify our school by May 28, 2010.



2. You must fill out a state transfer form and return in to NDPA by May 28, 2010. NDPA will send these forms to the district by June 30.

This form is not available yet because the USOE officials are still developing the form. We will notify you as soon as it becomes available.



KINDERGARTEN ASSESSMENTS AND SCREENING



Parents of 2010-11 incoming Kindergarten students: We have already started scheduling appointments to pre-screen and assess incoming Kindergarten students for Kindergarten readiness. If you have a student scheduled to attend next fall and have not arranged an appointment time, please contact the Mrs. Baker in the K-4 office to schedule one this week. Limited slots remain. 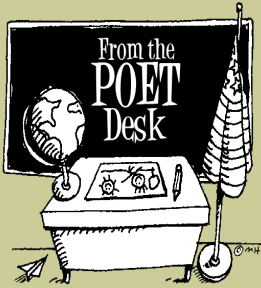
Standards for Dollar Dress Day:

Other standards include:

- Shorts and skirts need to be near the knee
- No tank tops
- No baggy pants
- No bare or stocking feet
- No open toe or open heeled shoes or slippers
- No clothing which displays obscene, vulgar, lewd, or sexually explicit words, messages or pictures, or clothing that is assumed to be gang related.
- No clothing that exposes bare midriffs, buttocks or undergar-
