ELEMENTARY DROP OFF AND PICK UP

POET has been working with NDPA staff to improve pick-up and drop-off times. You may have noticed parents holding signs to remind drivers about efficient car pool practices, like no parking in the pull through lane, and no left turn into the school lot. The system is designed so that cars line up next to the curb in the subdivision and pull forward, in turn, into NDPA parking lot. That leaves a lane in the street for cars proceeding toward Hill Field Road, unencumbered by cars waiting to enter the parking lot. The system works well if everyone follows the rules. Actually, we can get all 500 children picked-up within 15 minutes. Great goal huh!

9th GRADE TRIP TO SPAIN:

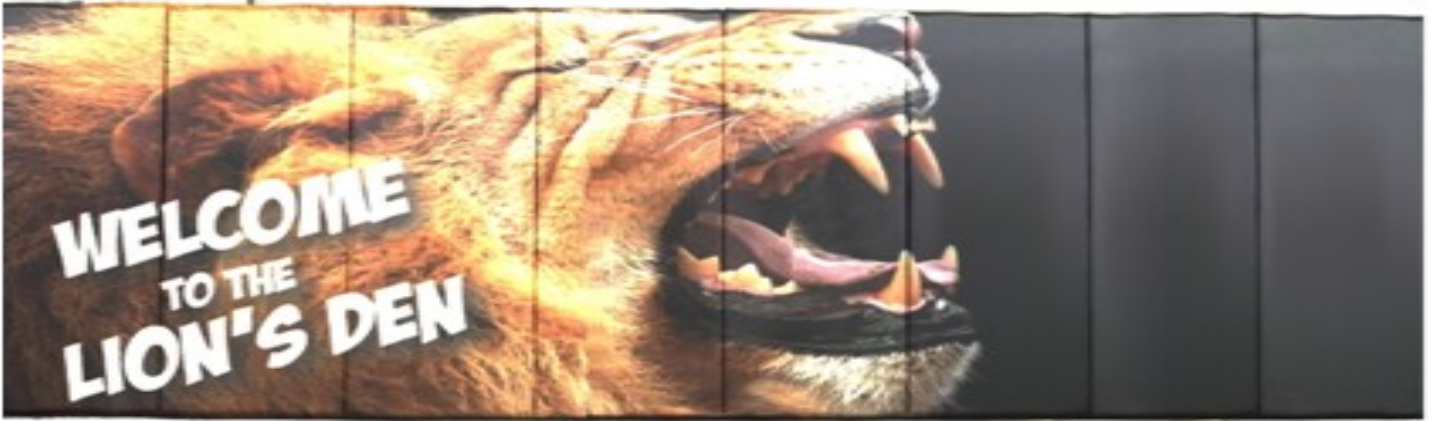

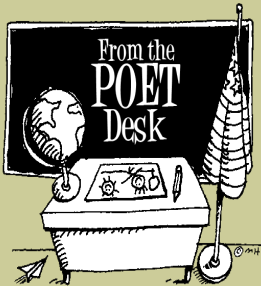
Games will start Tuesday at 3:30. Check with coach Dooley for teams and times.
