### **After-School Art Students & Parents**

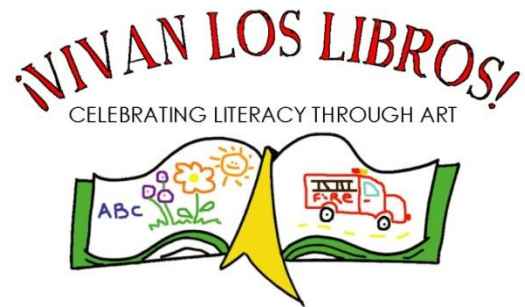
Just a reminder: After-school art will come to an end after our class next Wednesday, December 17<sup>th</sup>.
